This morning, John Shannahan, a countryman from Borrisoleigh, county Tipperary, while speaking to a passenger (holding on by the side irons) on board the *Erin-go-Bragh* steamer, at the lower quays, shortly after the shipping slide had been drawn, the vessel loose from her moorings, and getting under weigh, overreached himself between the ship and quay wall, fell into the river, and was drowned. The mother of the unfortunate man, who was on board when the fatal occurrence took place, was sent back in the jolly boat of the *Erin* by Captain Kennedy, commander. The body was found in an hour after.

The weather was very unpropitious for the last ten days to harvest labour, and the rains that have fallen since last Saturday swelled several fields of heavy corn. The hay crop, in most places, suffered by the incessant torrent that poured on Sunday, and the mountain floods caused partial inundation. This day looks bright and dry.

Patrick Cunneen, a labourer, from Pennywell, who left his house on Saturday evening the worse of liquor, after telling his wife he would have a "spree to himself," not returning same night or next day, search was made in the Canal, which was his way home, and on Monday morning the unfortunate man was found drowned in the basin.
