In the County Cork there was but one gaol while there are six counties in Ireland, each of which has its peculiar -gaol. On going over the committals for this year, he had reckoned 129 prisoners who had been committed at enormous expense to the county, the distances ranging from 40 to 75 miles to undergo a sentence of 14 days imprisonment, while 8 persons were sent a distance of 72 miles to be imprisoned for 48 hours, the period of whose imprisonment must have expired before they reached the gaol gate!
