

Hodgson Pratt, Esq. son in law of John Wetherell, Esq. of Birr, has been appointed under secretary to the government at Bengal.

The body of one of the foreign sailors recently drowned at Askeaton, was found yesterday.

The *Primrose*, of this port, sailed this morning for Quebec, with 250 passengers.

The passage fare for adults for New York, from Limerick, this season, is £4 5s, and to Quebec £3 7s 6d. Passenger vessels are very scarce.

The tide of emigration from this locality is so enormous that the berths in all the passenger vessels now in port have been secured! This day £5 was offered, and refused, for a passage to Quebec in the *Jane Black*.

John Nolan, for using an otter to capture fish in the Blackwater was fined £4 or a month's imprisonment on Monday at Fermoy sessions.

Mary O'Brien, wife of a farmer residing near Cahircionish, died suddenly on Thursday, in the shop of Mrs Russell, Wickham-st. Upon entering to purchase some goods she asked for a chair to sit upon, and expired instantly. Thomas Costelloe, Esq., coroner, held an inquest on the body—verdict, 'Died by the visitation of God.'

Ellen Lynch and Honora Shaw, the victims of the dreadful butchery at Philadelphia last month, were born in Killarney. They were daughters of John Donovan, the steward of the Earl of Kenmare. Arthur Spring is in custody at Philadelphia, accused of the robbery and murder.

Mr Wm Lee, for the last 5 years station master at Tipperary, has been appointed station master at Carrick on Suir by the Waterford and Limerick Railway company.

Yesterday the government inspector viewed the line of railway between Clonmel and Fiddown, which will be opened on Monday next for general traffic.

The approach to the railway at Athlone, which owing to some misunderstanding between the Ordnance department and the Railway company has been long closed to the public, will be immediately opened for traffic.
