At Kilkenny sessions Lt.-Col. Johnson of Ballyraggett, was decreed in 12^l, expenses of Thomas Hart, Esq. J.P. late High Sheriff, while attending in Dublin as witness in the action of libel against the *Kilkenny Moderator*.

Patrick M Inerny, a labourer, was killed on Friday while working at the new Ashbourne road—a stone which he was lifting with a winch having fallen on him and killed him on the spot.

At King's County Quarter Sessions in John Reenan, appellant; Francis V. Bennett, Esq., High Sheriff, respondent, the appellant was convicted by the local magistrates for trespass on a bog in pursuit of game; and the conviction by the Barrister was affirmed—penalty £5 and costs, and in default of payment, a fortnight's imprisonment in Tullamore gaol.

At Tipperary sessions, Edmond Hayes and Patrick Dwyer, little boys, for wilfully and maliciously placing stones on the Great Southern and Western Railway at Balloch, on the 17th ult, owing to which obstruction the guard of the engine was broken, pleaded guilty, and Sergeant Howley sentenced them to be imprisoned six months at hard labour. Patk. Head, a pensioner, for stealing two shirts from Sergeant Matthews, 13th Foot, three months at hard labour.

At Maryboro' petty sessions, on Tuesday, Mr. Daniel Farrell and Mr. C. Beale, bakers, were fined 1^l. each with costs, for having each a light 4lb weight. Mr. Cassan said that in future every baker brought before the court for light weights would be fined in the full penalty of 5^l. and costs.

A boy in the service of the Rev. Mr. Allen, Clonlara, was seriously injured at the Race course by a horse which struck out and kicked him on the head. Sub Inspector Heard had him removed to the police barrack for medical aid.
