 At the meeting of the Board of Guardians of the
 above Union on Thursday last, the chair was occu-
 pied by Mr. David Hammon.
 Others Guardians present—Messrs. Timothy
 Lynch, John Moloney, and Michael Kelly.
 The minutes of last meeting having been read and
 signed, the state of the House was reported thus:—
 Remaining as per last report, 278; admitted dur-
 ing the week, 14; discharged, 16; died, 1. Re-
 maining on last Saturday, 275; sick in hospital,
 63; in fever hospital, 49. Total number sick, 112.
 Rates lodged during the week —; paid by the treas-
 urer —; balance in favour of the Union, £15 10s 1d;
 uncollected rates, £1555 10s 1d; the cost of provi-
 sions &c., consumed during the week was £40 3s 3d;
 and the general average cost of an inmate for the
 week was 2s 10d; in the infirmary, 3s 10½d; in the
 fever hospital, 2s 9½d.
 The Board ordered that the inmates be supplied
 with white bread and tea for breakfast, and meat for
 dinner on Easter Sunday.
 The state of the collection of rates was consid-
 ered unsatisfactory, and it was ordered that the col-
 lector's attention be called thereto.
