THE TREATY OF COMMERCE notice has been issued by the Government in reference to the Treaty of Commerce with France: "All persons who have entered into contracts for the delivery, in whole or in part before the 1st of January, 1873, of goods the produce or manufactures of the Kingdom, which contracts require to be performed in whole or in part before the 1st of January, 1873, are required to give notice of said contracts at the Foreign Office within fourteen days from the date of the issue of this notice in order that they may be submitted to the Commission under the 21st article of the Treaty, with the view to ascertain the good faith of the said contracts, and that a copy of any contract can be received within a period of fourteen days from the date of the issue of this notice."
