SALFORD CATTLE, this day.—The supply of cattle was smaller and of sheep about the same as last week. The quality of beef was fair, but business was dull. Best sorts made 8½d per lb, while inferior qualities sold at from 7d to 8d per lb. The sheep trade was quiet, but prime light weights were firm in value, prices ranging from 10d to 10½d per lb. Calves sold slowly on former terms.
