## TINNED SALMON AND FRUIT THE TRADES OF CALIFORNIA.

The British Consul at San Francisco in his last report gives some striking figures showing the magnitude of trade in tinned or canned salmon and fruit. The total "pack" of salmon last year on the Pacific coast was 1,693,8000 cases, of 48 1-lb tins each, the prime value of which was £1,812,800. Of this enormous quantity 422,000 cases were packed in British Columbia. Six hundred and eighty thousand cases, the largest portion of the supply, came from the Alaska streams, 426,300 from Columbia streams, and the remainder from the rivers of California and Washington Territory.
