SCENES AT GOA.

has reached a very serious stage, correspondent of the *Daily News* says the troops are said to be committing excesses, shooting down the innocent. Several popular leaders were shot, and the houses of the rebels were set on fire. In defiance of the orders of the British Government, the soldiers maintained possession of arms. The rebels fled to Old Goa and taken refuge in the Cathedral and the Church of St. Francis. The Governor-General has ordered the troops to be kept in the palace, and is receiving petitions of the inhabitants. The British Government, however, stated to have bayoneted the children, who fled to the palace. It is reported that dynamite was exploded at the palace on Wednesday, killing several British soldiers, who suddenly fled from the military posts. Petitions were presented to the Government, and it is stated that the action of the British Government is a justification of the revolution had effected, which was to overturn the British rule, and to secure British intervention.
