Mr M P Bailey, says the *Chicago Citizen* of
October 15th, who had held several offices of trust
and emolument, federal and municipal, and who
was recognised as a leader of the Chicago Demo-
cracy, died last Saturday at his residence,
M'Allister place, of that city. He was born in
Limerick, Ireland, fifty-nine years ago, and came
with his family to Chicago when only ten years
old. He served in the Union Army during the
War of the Rebellion, and was always an active
and patriotic citizen. He leaves a grown up
family in good circumstances. Mr Bailey was a
gentleman of amiable disposition and had a host
of friends among men of all parties.
