EQUITY BUSINESS.

Entry and Lodgment of Civil Bills for Hearing. The plaintiff in every Equity suit shall lodge with the Clerk of the Crown and Peace in his office, on clear days at least before the return day, a copy of Civil Bill and of any notice, statement, or document theretofore served on him by the defendant or by him on the defendant in such suit.

CIVIL BUSINESS.

All Entries of Ordinary Civil Bills, Ejectment Defences, and other cases to be heard, must be lodged at the Crown and Peace Office, County Court House, Limerick, either by hand or by post, before the hour of 4 p.m., Two Clear Days, at least (excluding Sunday, Christmas Day, St. Stephen's Day, Good Friday, Whit Monday, and King's Birthday), before the first day of the Sessions in each town, on requisitions (Form No. 23). The Entries of Ordinary Civil Bills and Defences must be in Alphabetical Order of the Plaintiffs' names.
