MR. W. M. O'BRIEN, M.P., AND THE CORPORATION.

A special meeting of the Corporation had been
summoned for yesterday, in view of the attend-
ance of Mr. William O'Brien, M.P., to sign the
roll of Freeman, he having been admitted
thereto some seventeen years ago. The meeting
however collapsed for the reasons set forth in
the following letter written by Mr. O'Brien on
Sunday last :—

"MY DEAR MR. MAYOR—I have received the
message of the Town Clerk, in reference to to-
morrow's meeting of the Corporation, and I
deeply appreciate the honour paid me by the
invitation to complete my citizenship of your
renowned old city by signing the Roll of Hono-
rary Burgesses. But I am sure there will be a
general feeling that, as all the contemplated
presentations cannot take place on the same
occasion, it is not desirable under existing cir-
cumstances that any presentation could be made
in an individual case.

"On some future occasion I trust it may be
possible to arrange that the eminent leader of
the Irish Party and myself should receive to-
gether the distinguished municipal honour in-
tended for us by the noble-hearted citizens of
Limerick.
