**A PUBLICAN'S PLEA.**

(From our own Correspondent.)

At Glin Petty Sessions on Thursday, before Mr.  
 F. Fitzgerald (Chairman), Dr. McDonnell, Mr. S.  
 Pegum, and the Knight of Glin, Michael Sullivan,  
 publican, Ballyhabill, pleaded guilty to breach of  
 the Licensing laws. John Mangan, P. Mangan,  
 Thomas Fitzgibbon, Michael Kenrick, Patrick  
 Regan, and David O'Brien were also charged with  
 being on the premises.

Sergeant Davis proved the case.

The Bench expressed its approval of the  
 publican's action in admitting the offence, and he  
 was fined 20s and costs, not to be recorded. Those  
 found on the premises (excepting John Mangan  
 and M. Kenrick who believed themselves bona  
 fide travellers and who were fined 1s each), were  
 fined 2s 6d and costs.
