THE SPIRITS ACT.

HEAVY FINE.

At Belfast yesterday Frederick Hoey, of Messrs. Frederick Hoey and Co., wholesale spirit merchants, was summoned by the Inland Revenue for having in his possession a quantity of plain spirits removed from the Custom House, in contravention of the Spirits Act. He was further summoned for having in his possession a cask, which was being subjected to a process of extracting spirits that had been absorbed in the wood. A fine of £250 was imposed.

NARROW ESCAPE ON THE SHANNON.

Late on Sunday evening, while three men named Kennedy, McGrath, and Collins, of Garry, Kennedy were leaving Dromneer, owing to some unexplainable cause, the sailing boat in which the three men were, suddenly capsized close to the new pier. COLLISION IN THE NORTH CHANNEL.

SCHOONER SUNK.

The Earl of Beaconsfield, a three-masted schooner, belonging to Chester, was run into on Saturday night in the North Channel by the Manchester Commerce, of Liverpool. The Earl of Beaconsfield, which was in ballast, sank shortly afterwards. The crews were saved.

BOATING ACCIDENT ON THE SHANNON.

On Sunday evening about seven o'clock a very sad fatality occurred in the Shannon opposite Rhebogue Waterworks. Christopher McMahon was returning to the city in a breaun or flat-bottomed boat, when through some unexplained cause he fell over the side, and was drowned before assistance could be rendered. The deceased, who was 27 years of age, was by trade a baker. He was the only occupant of the boat at the time of the sad occurrence, which was witnessed only by a boy named Cullen, who was powerless to extend any aid. The body was recovered yesterday. An inquest was not considered necessary.
