DESTRUCTIVE FIRES.

Several Fatalities.

New York, Saturday.—It is reported from Bahia, Brazil, that a fire has broken out there, and that thirty-three buildings have already been destroyed. The firemen are apparently unable to check the flames, and several fatalities have occurred. The loss is estimated at one million dollars.

3,000 Persons Homeless.

Constantinople, Saturday.—A fire has destroyed about 400 houses in the poor Jewish quarter of the suburb of Hasskeny. Three thousand persons are homeless. The authorities are distributing relief.
