CINEMATOGRAPH EXHIBITIONS.

Sheffield Licensing Justices have decided to impose stringent regulations on all places of entertainment where cinematograph exhibitions are given. All such places of entertainment are to be connected by telephone with the fire station, and the licensee is to pay the cost of a city fireman's being in attendance during every performance. In every case the chief constable is to be satisfied that all reasonable precautions have been taken against accident and danger to the public. The cinematograph is to stand in a box constructed entirely of metal and asbestos. fitted with automatic doors and shutters; and the machine is to be cleaned and examined evuly day.
