### DEATH OF THE N. ARCHIBALD GORDON.

Press Association's Winchester correspondents—The Hon. Archibald Gordon, Lord Aberdeen, died this morning at the Hampshire County Hospital, Winchester, having resulted from heart failure consequent on internal injuries received in the car accident near Winchester recently. Mon. Archibald Gordon, who was the first of the Lord Lieutenant of Ireland's sons, was born in 1884.

He deceased was a close personal friend of the squith family, and but for his untimely death a closer tie was in contemplation.
