DEATH OF REV. J. G. FITZGERALD, P.P., CROOM.

We regret to record the death, which occurred on Thuesday, after a rather prolonged illness at the Parochial residence of Rev. John G. Fitzgerald, Parish Priest of Manister, Croom, in his 72nd year. The deceased clergyman, who was a native of Limerick, was educated at Maynooth, and he passed the whole of his ecclesiastical career in the diocese. He was for a time curate at Abbeyfeale, Glin, and other diocesan parishes, and for a brief period acted as Administrator of Glin. He was a popular and much-esteemed clergyman, and his death is very much regretted by his relatives and a wide circle of friends.
