Local Government Voters' Lists, for the Re-
vision of 1914, and the Register of Voters and
the Burgess Roll for 1915, in accordance with

Appointment of Supernumerary Night Con-
stable.
THE Watch Committee will, at a meeting to
be held on WEDNESDAY, the 8th JULY,
1914, at 7.30 o'clock p.m., appoint a competent
man as Supernumerary Night Constable. The
man to be appointed is to be subject to the
rules governing the permanent staff of the
City Night Constables, and must be of good
character, in sound physical condition, be sub-
ject to a medical examination, and must be
able to read and write. Age not to be less
than 25 years, or more than 35 years, and mini-
mum height 5 feet 6 inches. Candidates
must not belong to the Militia or the
Army or Navy Reserves, and men in perma-
nent employment are ineligible. Wages at the
rate of 22s per week for every night on duty,
certain articles of uniform, and a bonus of £6 a
year being allowed. Applications in own hand-
writing, accompanied by copies of testimonials
and Baptismal certificates, must be lodged
with the undersigned not later than 4 o'clock
p.m., on above date, endorsed "Application for
