## THE LATE MR WM CLOSE.

### The Inquest.

At the inquest held in London on Friday as to the death of the late Mr Wm M Close (21), a young Limerick citizen, and of Miss Agnes Martin (19), who was boating with him at the time of the regrettable occurrence, the jury found that it arose through accident on the previous Saturday. They hired a boat at Cleopatra's Needle, and rowed towards Blackfriars Bridge.

William Alfred Durant (18) said that he and a friend also hired a boat, and saw another boat alongside a barge which was moored in mid-stream, close to Blackfriars Bridge. "I thought it was two girls was in the boat," he explained "so we thought we would go over and get on. Then we saw it was a boy and a girl on the boat, and then I said, 'Jim, never mind, I will get on the barge and see what they are doing.' I climbed on the barge, and kept looking at the couple, but they were only smoking. As I was returning to our boat I was horrified to see the girl swept by the barge in the water.

"A moment afterwards I heard the splash of Close jumping in, and then I saw him swimming with the girl under his arm. He was swimming well, but just as the two were abreast of the bridge both went under, and I saw no more of them."

The Coroner (Dr Waldo).—What business was it of yours to get on the barge and look at these people?—None.

And you realise that it ended in the loss of two valuable lives?—Yes.

Turning to the jury, the coroner remarked: "It is a very sad thing. This young man, acting as Paul Pry, but to a certain extent paused the loss of two lives."

River Police-Sergeant Towney said that when Durant climbed on to the couple's boat after they had gone overboard the boat was nearly submerged, and in a minute Durant also would have been drowned.

The Coroner.—An' it would have served him right, too.

Witness added that Durant told him that the young woman fell overboard while untangling the boat from the barge.

The Foreman.—We are of opinion that had it not been for this "Peeping Tom" business the accident would not have happened, and we strongly censure both these youths.

## EARL OF ROSS FOUND DEAD.

The Press Association telegraphs.—The Earl of Ross was found dead yesterday morning at Birr Castle. He expired while taking his bath, shortly before which he appeared to be in his usual health. The deceased Earl fought in the Boer war and in the present war, and was severely wounded in the head whilst in action with the Irish Guards.

Deceased Peer was born in 1873. He was H.M.L. for King's County, and a Representative Peer for Ireland. He was prominently connected with the Royal Dublin Society, and was a member of several of its Committees. Lord Ross was also vice-president of the Irish Forestry Society. Locally he was a member of the Birr Union Council and of the Birr Technical Committee.
