TAKING OF HUMAN LIFE.

Most Rev. Dr. Harty's Condemnation. In reference to the murder of Constable Heaney at the Rags, Thurles, his Grace the Most Rev. Dr. Harty, Archbishop of Cashel, has addressed the following letter to the Parish Priest, Rev. Michael Finn, D.O.M.:

"My dear Father Finn, - Now that the inquest on the victim of the Rags shooting has made the situation sufficiently clear, I express to you my horror at that event. It is deplorable that men should so despise the laws of God as to take human life in this unbecomingly brutal manner."

The Rathkeale Tragedy.

Shooting of Sergeant Neazor. The Inquest and Verdict.

Additional details are now available of the shooting tragedy in the Hibernian Hotel, Rathkeale, on Wednesday night. They go to show that the outrage was evidently carefully planned. During the day, which was fair day in the town, the deceased, Sergeant George Neazor and Constable Garrett Doyle, who were in plain clothes, were protecting Michael O'Brien, a land steward from Rattoo Co. Kerry, who was doing business at fair.

CITY FATALITY.

An inquest was held yesterday by Mr J.F. Barry, Coroner, at the City Court-house, touching the death of James Downes, single, aged 38, an ex-soldier, who was found dead near the mouth of the Hinc-kiln in the Dock road on Thursday morning.

Troops Move on to Berlin.

Workers General Strike Proclaimed.

Berlin, Saturday. An immediate danger of a violent revolution has been threatened during the night. At midnight it was learned that bodies of revolting troops at Dohberitz, and two naval brigades had begun to move on Berlin. At five o'clock this morning the naval brigades were at Tiergarten station. Baltic troops also joined in the revolt. Generals were sent to warn the troops of the consequences of their action.
