DEATH OF MR ROBERT FROST.

Very general regret is felt in Limerick at the
 unexpected death of Mr Robert Frost at his resi-
 dence, St John's Avenue, on Tuesday night, after
 a comparatively brief illness. He took suddenly
 ill a few days ago and died on Tuesday night. Mr
 Frost was a former member of the Limerick
 Corporation and Chairman for some years of the
 Limerick Board of Guardians. He was a kindly,
 genial, and courteous citizen, and there is much
 sympathy with the relatives of the deceased. The
 remains lay overnight in St John's Cathedral
 whence the funeral for Mount St Lawrence Ceme-
 tery took place this afternoon.

DEATH OF MRS MCCARTHY.

The death, which is regretted by a large circle
 of friend, occurred on Sunday morning of Mrs
 Margaret McCarthy, at her residence, Sexton-
 street. The deceased was married twice. Her
 first husband was Mr T Peel, by whom she had
 three sons—Mr Tom Peel and Mr Peter Peel, now
 residing in Chicago, and Mr Joe Peel, who lives
 in Manchester. She secondly married Mr W.
 McCarthy, who was for many years a building
 contractor in the city. Her death, at a ripe age,
 is generally regretted, and this was demonstrated
 at the funeral, which took place on Tuesday for
 the family burial-place at Mount St Lawrence
 Cemetery.
