Statutory Undertakings (Temporary Increase of Charges) Act, 1918,

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Corporation of Limerick (hereafter referred to as "the Corporation") have made application to the Local Government Board for Ireland for an Order under the Statutory Undertakings (Temporary Increase of Charges) Act, 1918, to modify the provisions of the Limerick Corporation Gas Act, 1878, as already amended by Provisional Order made the 13th day of May, 1918, and confirmed on the 30th day of July, 1918, so as to enable the Corporation to charge for gas supplied by them to consumers a price not exceeding eight shillings for every thousand cubic feet consumed in the Borough, or nine shillings for every thousand cubic feet consumed elsewhere within the limits of supply, and so in proportion for any smaller quantity consumed.

Any representations in the matter of the said application may be made in writing by letter addressed to the Secretary of the Local Government for Ireland at the Custom House, Dublin, within three weeks from the date of the publication of this notice.

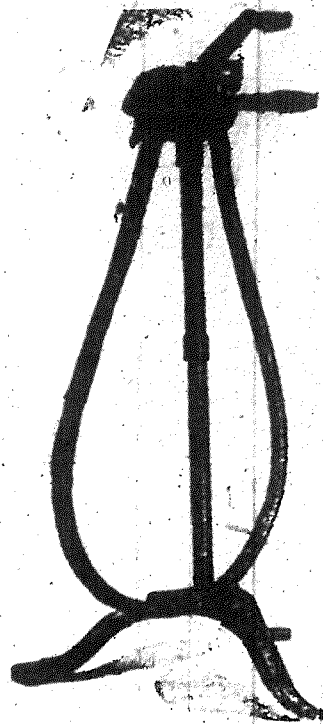
