## WATERFORD AND U.S. SHIPS.

It was intimated at Waterford Harbour Board meeting, relative to direct trade between New York and other United States' ports and Waterford, that the agent of the Moore McCormack Line was satisfied that there was ample water accommodation at Waterford. The company asked that only half dues should be charged when discharging only half cargoes, similar concessions being granted at Cork, Limerick, and Sligo. They were informed the request could not be acceded to, as Waterford Harbour Board, under their Acts, are bound to charge all ships equally.
