## COUNCIL OF PHARMACEUTICAL SOCIETY.

At the annual meeting of the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland the following were elected on the Council:—Mr W J Hardy, Belfast; Dr J A Walsh, Dublin; Mr A Wilson, Belfast; Mr Samuel Suffern, Belfast; Mr J Michie, Blackrock, Dublin; Mr V E Hanna, Dublin; and Mr J A Doyle, Dublin. Mr Wilson and Mr Doyle were new candidates. The other successful candidates had retired from the Council by rotation and sought re-election. At the October meeting of the Council, Dr A J Barnes, of Dublin, was elected President of the Society for the ensuing year, vice Mr J E Connor, J.P. Newry; Mr R Blair, Cork; Vice-President, vice Dr Barnes; Mr G D Beggs, J.P. Dalkey, was re-elected hon. treas.; and Mr G R M'Lean Lee, and Mr C E Digges, Dublin, were re-elected auditors.

## CUT IN MINERS' WAGES.

Sir W. Pender, chairman of the National Wages Board, has decided in an arbitration that the maximum reduction of coal miners' wages which owners are entitled to make this month is 3s and 1s 6d p. shift for men and youths, respectively. He further rules that coal owners are responsible for only 72.6 p.c. of last month's wages, whereas the Mines Department contended they should pay 97.57 p.c. of the 1915 standard rates.

## YOUNG CITY MAN'S DEATH.

Michael McKenna, aged 20, died rather unexpectedly on Sunday morning while proceeding from his residence in the Garryowen district to St John's Cathedral. He took suddenly ill, it seems, on the way, and was brought to Barrington's Hospital, where life was found to be extinct. He was a popular young fellow and had previously been in poor health.

## KILRUSH PORT.
