**HUNTING.**

- (1) Any person found in the possession of arms without a permit from the O.C. of said area shall be liable to suffer the extreme penalty.
- (2) All licensed houses shall close between the hours of 9 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- (3) All persons shall be indoors between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- (4) All persons, when called upon to halt by patrols, shall immediately do so.
- (5) Any person who, owing to urgent business, must pass through the said area within the above-mentioned hours, can do so by having a permit from the O.C.
- (6) All citizens are requested to co-operate with the authorities in tracking down murderers and robbers.

**THE LATE POPE BENEDICT XV.**

Solemn Requiem High Mass was celebrated at St John's Cathedral this morning at 10.30 for the repose of the soul of his late Holiness Pope Benedict XV. The Most Rev Dr Hallinan, who presided, made an impressive reference to the late Pontiff, his efforts for the good of mankind, and his deep interest in Ireland and her people. The celebrant of the Mass was Rev Father Connolly, Adm., St John's; deacon, Rev Fr Riss, C.C., do.; sub-deacon, Rev Fr O'Carroll, O.C., do.; master of ceremonies, Rev Fr F J MacNamara, O.C., do. There was a very large attendance of the clergy and general public. Solemn Requiem Masses were also celebrated in the other city Catholic Churches.
