**DEATH OF MR WILLIAM RIORDAN, JUNIOR.**

The death, which we announce with regret, took place in St John's Hospital yesterday morning of Mr William Riordan, eldest son of Mr William Riordan, O'Connell Avenue, of the firm of Messrs. O'Mara, Ltd. The deceased young gentleman had been ailing only a few days, having undergone an operation for appendicitis. Pneumonia supervened, and the end came peaceably yesterday morning. He was for some years traveller for Messrs. O'Mara, Ltd., bacon curers, and was son-in-law of Mr E. J. Long, a former High Sheriff of the City, and ex-President of the Chamber of Commerce. His death in the prime of life has occasioned great regret in the city, and the utmost sympathy is felt for his young widow and family in their bereavement.
