From a financial point of view, barley is  
 the soundest cereal crop at the present  
 time. "Agricultural Gazette" (England).  
 The samples are practically as good as a  
 gold mine while secondary barley is the most  
 valuable of all our cereals for feeding to pigs.  
 Well-drained medium to sandy loams are  
 the best for the crop, it can be grown  
 in the same way. It is possible to ex-  
 pect a crop in the northern counties where  
 it is normally too late for success. Since  
 it is shallow rooted and quickly growing  
 it is essential to obtain a uniform seed bed  
 and to keep it free and dry.
