Distressing Drowning Accident

In West Limerick.

Child Falls Into Quarry and is Drowned.

Mother Loses her Life in Attempted Rescue.

Our Newcastle West correspondent wires: -

A distressing and pathetic double drowning fatality occurred at Glenroe, about five miles from Newcastle West, yesterday, by which a child named Jer. Lynch, aged about 10 years, was drowned, and his mother met the same fate in a heroic attempt to rescue him.

From news to hand, it appears the child was playing in the vicinity of a quarry, in which there is a pond of water about 12 feet deep.

In an attempt to recover a ball from the water the child fell into the pond. The mother, who was in the vicinity, hearing the cries of the child, sprang without hesitation to his rescue, and there being nobody in the vicinity at the time only her little daughter, who ran for help, both were drowned before help could be forthcoming.

When some neighbours reached the spot the water was quite still, mother and son having disappeared. Dragging operations were at once resorted to, and the bodies were recovered, but life was extinct.
