"SUMMER TIME" ENDING IN FREE STATE.

"Summer Time" will come to an end in the Free State on Sunday, the 20th of the present month, when all the clocks will be put back one hour.

In Great Britain and Northern Ireland "Summer Time" will continue until October 4th, so that for a fortnight there will be an hour's difference in the times here and in Great Britain and on the Northern side of the border.

Owing to the fact that there will be no sitting of the Dail or Senate before November next, the Minister for Justice is unable to make an Order extending the time in the Free State.
