DEATH OF MR. R. M. HENNESSY, K.C.

We regret to announce the death, which occurred at his residence, 6 York Terrace, Cork, last Saturday, of Mr Richard Martin Hennessy, K.C., one of the best known advocates at the Irish Bar. Mr Hennessy, who was called in the Michaelmas Term of 1877, was engaged in many celebrated trials, and for a long period occupied the office of Crown Counsel for Cork City. He was elected a Bencher of the King's Inns in November, 1913. As an able and painstaking advocate, a scholar and a wit, he was much respected, not alone by his brethren of the Senior Bar, but by all who knew him. Mr Hennessy was well and popularly known in Limerick, as for many years he went on the Munster Circuit.

CITY SUDDEN DEATH.

Mr Daniel Gleeson, an old and respected citizen, was found yesterday morning dead on the Island Bank, some short distance from his home. The deceased was at one time a well-known member of the Limerick Pigbuyers' Association, and death is stated to be due to natural causes. The late Mr Gleeson had attained an advanced age, and the sympathy of the public will be extended to his family in their sorrow.
