

DEATH OF MR. R. M. HENNESSY, K.C.

We regret to announce the death, which occurred at his residence, 6 York Terrace, Cork, last Saturday, of Mr Richard Martin Hennessy, K.C., one of the best known advocates at the Irish Bar. Mr Hennessy, who was called in the Michaelmas Term of 1877, was engaged in many celebrated trials, and for a long period occupied the office of Crown Counsel for Cork City. He was elected a Bencher of the King's Inns in November, 1913.
