EMPLOYMENT'S HIGH WATER MARK IN CANADA.

Ottawa, Sunday—The employment index of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the beginning of June is 105.9 which is the highest of any month in the past seven years and compares with 100.6 for May 1st. During the month nearly 44,000 were added to the pay rolls of firms reporting to the Bureau, increased employment being recorded in all provinces, particularly in the manufacturing, mining and construction industries.
