Mr McGilligan, Minister for Industry and Commerce, whose sudden illness prevented his attendance at the meeting last night, returned to Dublin last evening, being somewhat improved.

DEATH OF MR J. CORBETT.

The death took place at 5 Lord Edward Terrace, Roxboro' Road, yesterday, of Mr James J Corbett, after an illness of some duration. The deceased, who was 61 years of age, was storekeeper Great Southern Railways since 1900, just after the passing of the Amalgamation Act, and for some years anterior to being appointed to that position he served with the old Waterford and Limerick Railway Company.

The late Mr Corbett was for over forty years a member of the Arch-Confraternity of the Holy Family, and was a native of Clare, being grand-nephew of the late Rev. Fathers Daniel and Patrick Corbett, Quin.

The funeral took place to-day to Mount St Laurence Cemetery, and the representative character of the cortege testified to the respect in which the deceased was held in the city.
