**IRISH MARBLE**

**Growing Use in Building Construction**

Irish marble has lately come very much  
into favour for construction and decorative  
purposes in building schemes.

Its use has been stimulated by public  
bodies insisting that Irish marble should be  
used as far as possible in new buildings, and  
private builders have followed the lead thus  
given.

There has followed a decided fillip to the  
marble quarrying industry, and extensive  
and valuable marble quarries in some of the  
Free State counties are now being worked  
to full capacity.

Pure black marble is being quarried near  
Galway, and black with white streaks and  
sections at Kilkenny, while the unique green  
marble of Connemara is much sought after  
for decorative use indoors.

Under the name of "Irish green" the  
yellow-green variety found at Ballynahinch,  
and the tinted, striped stone at Lissoughter  
are coming into request, as is also the rich  
red marble of quarries in County Cork.

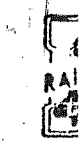
