## CURRAGH FATALITY.

### Funeral of Mr J. H. Harty.

The remains of the late Mr J. H. Harty, Alston, Croom, one of the leading Irish professional jockeys, who received fatal injuries while riding Mr T. K. Laidlaw's Kirkurd in the Experts' Stakes at the Curragh, on Wednesday, reached Limerick at 1.30 yesterday by train from the Curragh, after Requiem Mass had been celebrated at the Garrison Chapel, Curragh Camp, by the Rev. Father Donnelly, C.F. They were awaited at the terminus by a very large concourse of sporting people from the county and city, and accompanied by relatives and Dublin and Curragh residents. As the cortege passed through the city to Mount St. Laurence Cemetery, blinds were drawn in private and business houses. The coffin was strewn with wreaths of natural flowers. Amongst them, besides those from the family and friends, were those from the Stewards and members of the Turf Club, the Stewards of the Irish National Hunt Steeplechase Committee, and his fellow jockeys.
