## ALLOWANCES FOR EX- MINISTERS.

### Joint Committee in Favour of Pensions.

The report of the Joint Committee of the  
Dail and Seanad which considered the  
general question of the remuneration of  
Ministers and the allowances payable to  
members of the Oireachtas was issued last  
night.

It recommends that Ministers' salaries  
remain as at present, and that a scheme be  
introduced providing for special allowances  
for ex-Ministers for a period after their re-  
tirement from office.

The majority of the Committee held that  
the present scale of salary was insufficient to  
permit of Ministers while in office making  
any provision for their own future.

It was also decided that no change be  
made in the allowances to Deputies and  
Senators, and extended travelling facilities  
were recommended.

### DEATH OF MR JOHN F GREEN.

We regret to announce the death, which
