

The above-named Committee are prepared to supply Forest Trees to bona-fide farmers resident in the County of Limerick, as far as the allocation of £100 goes, under the following conditions:—

1. Applicant to pay one-half the cost of the trees supplied.
2. Maximum cost of a plot to the Committee not to exceed £3.
3. Number of trees to be supplied to be not less than 300 nor more than 1,200, or area to be planted to be not less than 1/4 acre nor more than 1 acre.
4. The site, and species of Forest Trees to be planted, must be first approved of by the Committee.
5. Applicants must fence the selected plot at their own expense before the trees are supplied, and at all times afterwards during a period of five years, and at a like expense, to keep the said fencing in sufficient repair to the satisfaction of the Committee.
6. Applicants at their own expense to supply all such labour and assistance as, in the opinion of the Committee, may be necessary for the success of the plot planted.
