WATER SUPPLY INCREASE.

The Water Committee last night decided to advertise for tenders for laying an additional pipe line to increase the city water supply, and for the installation at Clareville works of a system of mechanical filters, as recommended by Professor Purcell, consulting engineer. For the purpose the Corporation has borrowed a loan of £20,000 on long term credit, and when the contract is carried through the pressure at the high level will be considerably increased and a purer supply of water available.
