KILRUSH MARKET HOUSE

To be Re-Built.

At Kilrush Urban Council, Mr Thomas Nagle, P.C. (Chairman) presiding, the following letter re the Market House was received from Mr Fionan Lynch, Minister for Lands and Fisheries:—"Re deputa-tion of delegates; I received in Kilrush some weeks ago in connection with the re-building of the above, I am glad to be able to inform you that the Department for Local Government and Public Health is making you a free grant of £500 and a loan of £1,000, free of interest, for the reconstruc-tion of the Market House. I hope this will be replaced by a building worthy of the capital of West Clare."

Chairman—I am very glad we have achieved something to our credit at last, as since I came into office I kept on applying for something to be done to that building which has been an eyesore to our town for years.

Mr Hughes—Great credit is due to you, Mr Chairman, as you kept at it hammer and tongs all the time and now you are reward-ed for it.

A cordial vote of thanks was passed to Mr Lynch for his efforts in the matter, and the Clerk was directed to advertise for con-tractors.

Rev. Canon Adderley, M.A., Rector of Listowel, was unanimously elected Chairman of the North Kerry Agricultural and In-dustrial Show Committee, and Mr Wm. McElligott, the Arms Hotel, Vice-Chairman. Very Rev. Canon White was re-elected President.
