his companion. The incident attracted very little attention, but the Civic Guards were subsequently informed, and were engaged during the night instituting inquiries. The seized minute book contained no reference to any resolution condemnatory of murder, or to any political subject, as it merely dealt with public health matters.

No arrest has yet been made in connection with the affair.
