#### Weekly Cattle and Sheep Market.

Wednesday, November 25th.—Cattle—Lesser entry than last week; the depressed atmosphere in trade continues and overcast the market; in stores buyers showed little disposition to invest, and concession was needed by buyers to effect exchange; trade lacked life and followed an uncertain and inanimate trend; feeders cautious, fearing cattle may be lower; lukewarm competition; quiet demand, unless for calves, which sold well; value position weak; lots cashed were round about last week's quotations. Cows, £10 15s—£14 10s; 2½-year-old heifers, £11—£14; 1½-year-old bullocks, £9 10s—£10 17s 6d; heifers, £8—£10 15s; calves, £6

10s—£8 16s. Sheep—Considerable increase in numbers; trade quiet on the lower basis of prices, unless for good sheep, which made full current rates; ewes hard to place. Fat middle-weight, £2 5s—£2 13s; small, £1 14s—£2 3s; lambs, fat, 32s 6d to 42s; stores, 23s 6d to 29s. Practical clearance.—Wm. B. Fitt, Auctioneer.
