LIMERICK CIRCUIT COURT.

Judge McElligott, K.C., will open the business of the Circuit Court at 11 o'clock on Friday morning. The civil side of the calendar is not on this occasion heavy, and consists of ejectments, ordinary civil bills (defended and undefended), workmen's compensation claims, and equity suits. The criminal calendar from the city is confined to two charges, one of alleged fraudulent conversion and the other of forgery, while from the county there are also two cases listed, one of house-breaking and the other of indecency.

OBSEQUIES OF A NUN.

In St. John's Cathedral this morning the obsequies took place for the late Sister Mary Rexebe Dormody, who died in St. John's Hospital on Saturday night at an advanced age. The deceased was for a number of years attached to the Nursing Community of the Order of the Little Company of Mary, and spent a considerable portion of her religious career in St. John's Hospital, where she was held in affectionate regard by her sisters in religion and by the general public. His Lordship, the Most Rev. Dr. Keane, presided at the solemn Requiem Mass, the celebrant of which was Rev. Father Doody, C.C., St. John's; deacon, Rev. Father Rice, C.C., do.; sub-deacon, Rev. Father O'Regan, C.C., St. Mary's, and master of ceremonies, Rev. Father Brassill, C.C., St. John's. There were several clergy in the choir.
