INSURANCE ACT.

Interesting Point.

At the City District Court yesterday, Joseph Good, Upper William street, was summoned for failing to stamp Unemployment and National Health Insurance cards in respect of a man named Edward Murphy, alleged to be in his employment.

Mr J. J. Power, State Solicitor, appeared for the State.

Mr Cook, National Health Insurance Inspector, stated that Murphy had not insurance cards. When interviewed, Good stated that Murphy was not insured, and was not insurable, and Murphy stated likewise. Mr Good said that Murphy received about £2 10s a week from him for work performed, but said that he was not a workman of his.

Mr Good said Murphy had a workshop in his yard, but worked for himself. If he gave Murphy an order to make some furniture he could do so the same as if he was making it for anyone else, and witness paid him. That was the only arrangement.

In cross-examination, defendant said in the case of an order for furniture Murphy could get the material from witness's sawmill and the cost of the material would be deducted from the total cost of the completed article. Murphy paid him 5s a week for the workshop.

Mr Power said the procedure in cases of this kind was to refer them to the Minister, and he asked that the case should be adjourned for six months.

The Justice granted the adjournment asked for.
