list. But an attendant thus appointed who fails to obtain a certificate in Mental Nursing within four years of date of appointment must leave the service.

The following is the scale of salaries attached to the above positions, subject to any alteration the Committee may consider it necessary to make from time to time:—

(a) Female attendants, £42 per annum, increasing by £6 per annum to £72, with allowances (including apartments, rations, fuel, light, washing and uniform), which are valued for pensionable purposes.

(b) An additional £5 per annum to attendants who obtain the Mental Nursing Certificate.

N.B.—The examination for this is not a severe test, and every facility to prepare for it will be given in the form of instruction, lectures, etc., by the Assistant Medical Officer.

(c) An additional £7 10s per annum to Deputy Charge Attendants, which position is obtained on promotion by seniority, coupled with efficiency.

(d) An additional £15 per annum to Charge Attendants likewise appointed on promotion by seniority, with efficiency. The service permits an average of 2½ days off duty each week. Day Attendants are allowed a fortnight's holiday per annum. Night Attendants three weeks. All candidates, it must be understood, are appointed subject to a twelve months' probation period. The conditions of the Asylum Officers' Superannuation Act, 1909, are applicable to the persons appointed.
