DEATH OF MR VINCENT J. MURRAY.

We regret to announce the death of Mr Vincent J. Murray, Sporting Editor of the “Cork Examiner,” which took place at his residence in that city last night after an illness of some months. A son of the late Lieut.-Col. Murray, Army Veterinary Corps, he was one of the best known and popular sporting writers in Ireland, and in the old days was a familiar figure at meetings in County Limerick. Courteous and obliging, he was a valued Press colleague, and by all who had the pleasure of his acquaintance his death is deeply mourned.
