FATAL SEIZURE.

Limerick Farmer's Death.

At an inquest held by Dr. J. P. Cleary,
Coroner for East Limerick, into the circum-
stances of the death of Timothy Bresnihan,
farmer, Killanahan, Croom, a verdict of
death from natural causes, probably due to
heart failure, was recorded.

Evidence was given that deceased left his
home to attend 9 o'clock Mass at Croom,
and when he did not return a search was
made, and his dead body was found about
midday a short distance from his house,
which is situated some couple of hundred
yards from the road. Deceased appeared to
be in his usual good health up to the time
of his death. He was aged about 64.
