

... which, as stated, has been refused. The step now rests with the Corporation which must put up a more conclusive scheme is to be undertaken at an early date. The project has been long in contemplation to have work now, but there were other reasons which had the effect of holding progress. What case the Corporation make in support of its choice of the class house is rather speculative, whatever form it takes the Local Government Department will require to be convinced that the increased expenditure is justified in the interests of the workers. The scheme is, undoubtedly, the most comprehensive yet undertaken by local authority, and it is rather unfortunate that a hitch has occurred at this critical juncture which may have the effect of deferring the completion of the scheme for some time. The workers of the city are badly in need of employment, and as the summer months are the most favourable for building it is to be hoped that a way will be found to break through the present impasse, which will tend to the completion of the scheme before many weeks will have elapsed. Houses for workers are greatly needed in this city; the problem of providing decent accommodation was never so acute, and it is for that reason that the Corporation should strive to meet the wishes of the Department. If the Corporation cannot, owing to the operation of labour conditions, come to an agreement with the central authority, it is to be feared that the Island Field scheme will suffer a serious set-back, and the same may apply to the other schemes at the Killalee site.
