DEATH OF REV. M. CARROLL

The death took place on Sunday in St. John's Hospital, after an illness of some duration, of the Rev. Martin Carroll at a fairly advanced age. The deceased, who was a native of Croom, was ordained in Maynooth, and ministered as curate in several parts of the diocese. The obsequies took place on Tuesday, at 11 o'clock, in St. John's Cathedral, at which the Very Rev. Canon O'Dwyer, P.P., V.F., St. Munchin's, presided. The celebrant of the Requiem High Mass was Rev. W. J. Carroll, C.C., St. Michael's; deacon, Rev. Fr. Wilmot, C.C., Askeaton; sub-deacon, Rev. Fr. Halpin, C.C., Parteen; and master of ceremonies, Rev. Fr. Brassill, C.C., St. John's.

There were forty priests in the choir. The chief mourners were—Mr E. Carroll, brother; Mrs. McDonnell, Kildorrery, sister; Mr A. J. McDonnell, V.S., brother-in-law, and other relatives.

The interment took place in Mount St. Lawrence Cemetery.
