Found Dead in Her Home

Miss Mary Griffin, shopkeeper, was found dead on Wednesday morning at her residence, 24 Broad street. Deceased, who was aged about 70 years, had not been seen out of her house for about 24 hours, and several of the neighbours knocked at the doors and windows but got no response. On being notified the Guards at John street barracks proceeded to the house, and on gaining admittance by a back door, found the woman lying dead on the kitchen floor. All the doors and windows were also found to be locked, which showed that Miss Griffin was living alone.

On receiving a medical certificate, which stated that deceased had died from heart trouble, Mr J S MacNeice, City Coroner, did not deem an inquest necessary.
